- **What age groups do you have at Twilight Football?**

- **Is this competition different to previous years?**

This year's Twilight Football competition will be administered by the AWFA and as such, may operate slightly differently than previous summer competitions. We're currently finalising the competition format and operational details and will announce further details soon.

- **Does the AWFA provide Referees?**

Yes, AWFA will appoint referees for all games through the Albury Wodonga Soccer Referees Association (ASWRA).

- **What your fees go towards**

- **How do you capture the score from each game?**

- **Do we play in School Holidays or on Long Weekends?**

Yes, Summer Football continues to run during school holidays and over long weekends. Each competition operates on different days – please check our fixtures tab for up-to-date game information specific to your comp.

- **Do we play if it rains?**

All Twilight Football competitions are held on grass surfaces which means rain does not stop play. Games may be cancelled due to lightning, in which case you will be notified via Dribl and on social media.

- **What do we wear?**

Each team is to wear matching shirts. It is suggested that your shorts and socks are all the same colours. All players must wear football boots as per the laws of the game and shin pads must also be worn for player protection.

- **I was injured while playing. What do I do?**

All our registered players are insured through the FNSW insurance program.

- **What happens if we can't play a match during the Twilight Football season?**

We understand that sometimes teams cannot play. A forfeit will be registered against your team, and the opposing team will be notified.
